Description: Twenty-one of the finest High School Marching Bands from Washington, Oregon and Idaho will be competing in the Harvest Marching Band Festival involving over 3000 musicians and 5000+ spectators. Each band performs a ten-minute show including wind and percussion musicians, flag teams, rifle squads, dance teams, etc. for judging. The top 12 bands compete in the finals. This festival has quickly become one of Washington's premier marching band competitions. Most of the bands are returnees along with several new challengers.
